

If you need surgery for an orthopedic issue, there is an alternative to the complexity of hospital-based centers. OrthoVirginia's Operatory is a private, safe and convenient center, and it's located right within our office at St. Mary's Hospital in Richmond. This cost-effective surgical facility is designed to make your experience pleasant and comfortable, from the moment you walk into our light-filled, quiet reception area through the time you are discharged.



OrthoVirginia opened its Operatory in January 2003. Unlike traditional hospital settings where hundreds of procedures are performed each day, we specialize exclusively in orthopedic surgery.

Our Board-certified or Board-eligible physicians are the only surgeons who use the facility. Since we see fewer patients than hospitals do, and since all procedures are scheduled in advance, your waiting time is significantly reduced. We're also able to devote more time to your surgery and your pre- and postoperative care than many hospital-based facilities can.

The Operatory is accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC). Our medical director, Jack Summers, MD, manages all anesthetic and perioperative medical patient care. Dr. Summers is a Board-certified anesthesiologist with Total Anesthesia, formerly known as Anesthesia Associates of Richmond. He and our highly qualified operating room nurses are on the premises at all times the facility is open.

These team members, along with our certified nurse anesthesiologists and support staff, ensure that you receive the most skilled care available.

Upon arriving at the Operatory, you will register and then be escorted to the pre-op suite to prepare for your procedure. You will have the opportunity to speak with your surgeon and your anesthesia team, who will answer questions and address concerns.

Your surgery will be performed in one of the Operatory's spacious surgery suites. These suites



are furnished with state-of-the-art medical equipment to assist your surgeon in successfully completing your procedure. And should the need arise, the operatory is within close proximity to additional advanced medical facilities.

Immediately after your surgery, you'll be taken to our post-op suite. Here, our nurses will assist and reassure you until you are sufficiently recovered. Any necessary braces or special equipment will be thoroughly explained to you, and you will receive written follow-up care instructions from your doctor. Once you are home, expect our call to check on your progress and answer questions. An OrthoVirginia orthopedic specialist is on call 24 hours a day, all year, and can be reached by calling the main office numbers.

We believe that patients should have choices when making important healthcare decisions. The OrthoVirginia Operatory is an attractive option to hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers, and it observes strict protocols for maintaining sterile conditions and access to emergency care.
